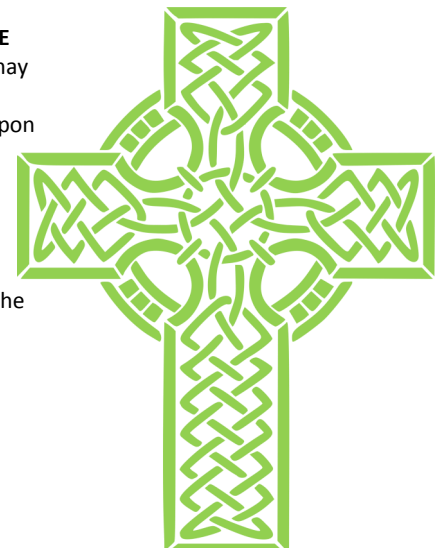
### PRAYER OF ST. AIDAN OF LINDISFARNE
