Why give through the PGS

The team at PGS make it safe and easy for you to give and just as safe and easy for your church to receive; easing the administration burden for treasurers & volunteers. <https://www.parishgiving.org.uk/home/>

How it Works - The scheme enables you to:

- Give monthly, quarterly or annually by Direct Debit or one-off payment
- Sign up to inflation linked giving annually, if you choose.
- Enhance your gift by having Gift Aid at 25% added to your giving.
- Give securely & Give anonymously, if you prefer.

Reviewing your gift/Managing your giving online

All existing givers can review & manage their current giving and add new gifts online, even if you originally set up giving by post or phone.

If you are using this website for the first time, you will need to set up an online account. Go to 'Sign in' on the menu, and then select 'Activate Account' and you'll be invited to activate your account by email. If you wish to use the same email address that you have previously provided for correspondence, the website will recognise your email address.

However, if as a giver you have not yet provided the PGS with an email address, please contact them first so they can update your records and verify your identity. You can do this on 0333 002 1260, or email

Having set up your online account, you can then log-in securely at any time to update your personal contact information, the value of your current gift, choices about Gift Aid, inflationary increase and anonymity status, or to add a new gift.

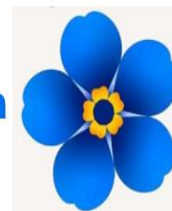
