Parish Giving Scheme reminder

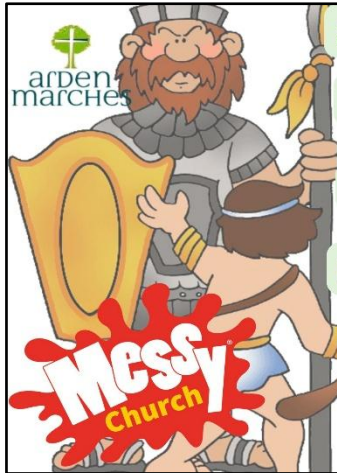
