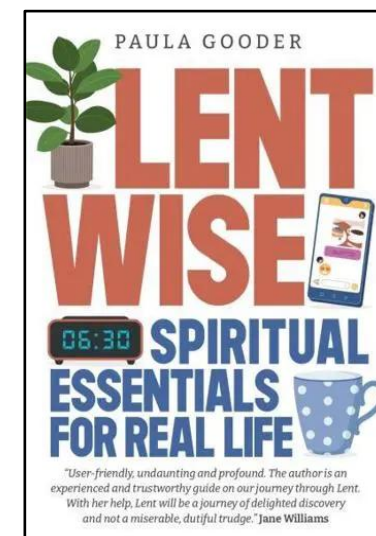

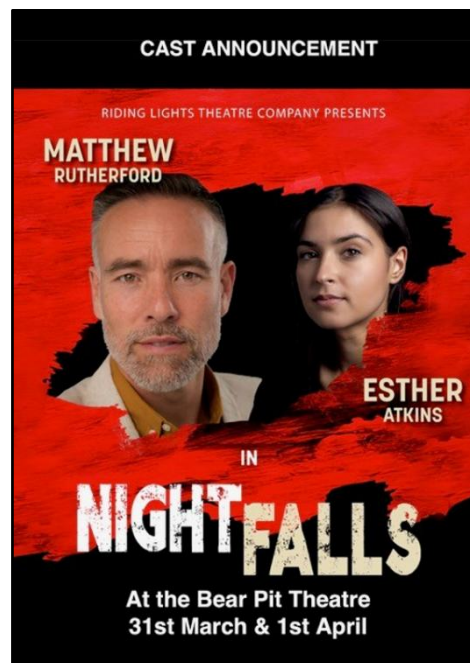
A selection of security leaflets / booklets / window stickers and some crime prevention equipment will also be available for you to take away.
