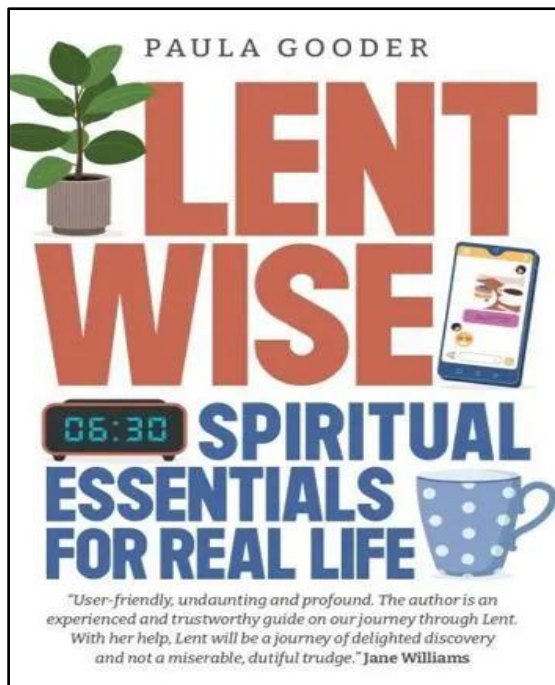

Lent Course

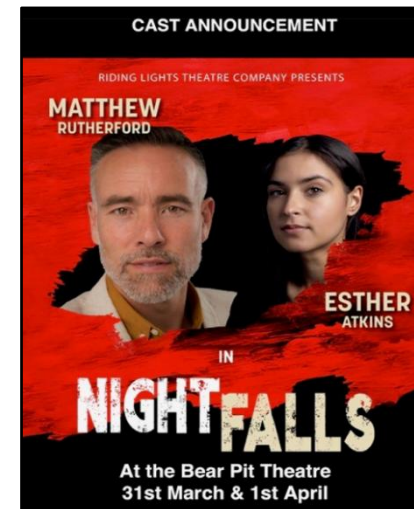
