Moonwalk in Aid of Cancer Charities

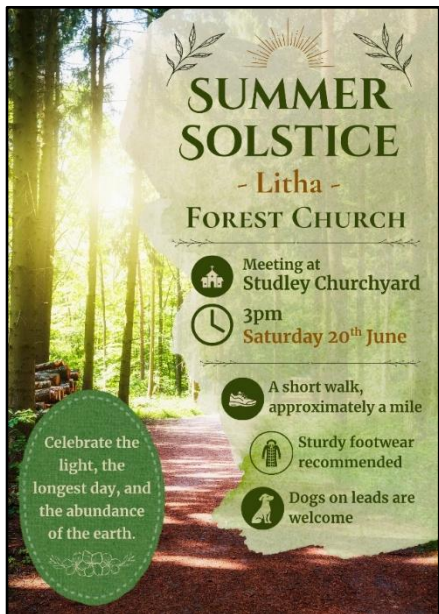
