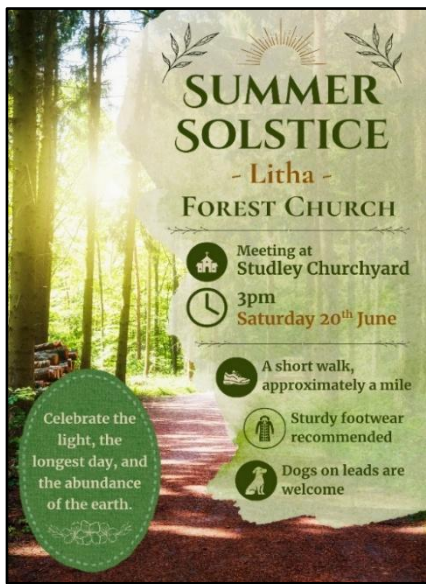

on Sunday 28th June from 2.30-4.30pm.

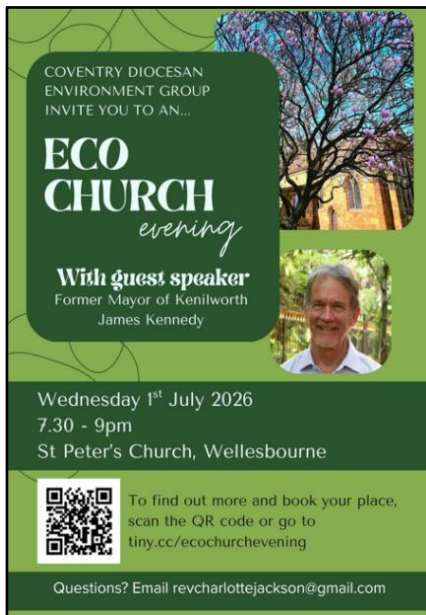
