HEADLINE:

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

The new GDPR becomes law on May 25th 2018. It replaces the existing data protection laws and gives individuals more rights as to how their data is used.

Each Parish and Incumbent are legally required to follow the regulations.

Over the next few weeks we will be doing a data audit to establish what data we hold, not just at the admin office but every church group. We need to know what is held, where and how it is stored and who has access to it.

We also need to get "consent" to hold and use your personal data. So there is a CONSENT FORM that everyone MUST fill in and sign. Without consent we cannot use your existing data after 25th May.

CONSENT FORMS are in church and once completed should be handed to either the church wardens or myself.

There will be more information/notices about GDPR over the next weeks.

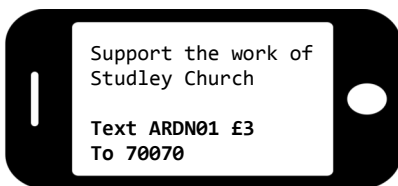
