All Souls Day (31st October) is a traditional time to remember those we love. No need to book, just call in and stay as long as you wish. If all available seats are occupied we will ask you to wait until one becomes available.

Studley Church - keeping contact through the next phase of Coronavirus

Our rota of phone calls which we started in March is coming to an end soon. We want to remain connected to one another, but just in a more sustainable way for the next season. Everyone in the church (who would like to) will be assigned to one of several small pastoral teams. The team (typically 3-4 people) will liaise between themselves and discuss with you how you would like to keep in touch. Those who would like or need regular calls will still get them. Those who are happy for less frequent contact, or are in contact with church through other means may want to agree a lighter-touch approach. The important thing is that everyone can feel sure there's someone in the church who knows how they are and if they might need anything.

If you previously opted out of the phone calls, or have never received them, but would like someone to be in touch, please contact Dan. If you currently receive calls, one of your new team will be in touch soon to introduce themselves.
