

Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 18-25th January

The visible unity of all Christians across all denominations is vital for our mission and outreach - Jesus prayed for it for this reason - John 17:21. So this annual week of prayer is close to my heart. There is a **booklet with readings, reflections and prayers** for you to use each day - *copies available in churches this weekend, or electronically*. The material has been prepared by Christians in the Middle East living in a time of turmoil, and focusses on the visit of the wise men to Jesus.

This year we will hold a joint service for Christians of all denominations to pray together for our mission and outreach on **Candlemas Sunday 30th January 4.00pm in Mappleborough Church**. The church is on a hill overlooking our villages and Redditch, so is an appropriate place to stand and pray God's blessing on our neighbourhoods. Candlemas is the day we remember the infant Jesus being taken into the Temple, the heart of Jewish worship, where Simeon proclaimed that he would be a light for all nations - so we will take the light of Christ outside the church (weather permitting!) as part of our prayer together. All are welcome to join us. We also encourage you to light a candle and place it in a window as a witness to the light of Christ shining in our street and drawing us together to worship Jesus.
